In order to determine success, we must first determine what success looks like. Following is a sample Mission Statement you are welcome to adapt for your church's use according to your church's vision for children's ministry.

By the time Primary School aged children are ready for High School, they should ...

- ✤ Receive the free gift of salvation
- ✤ Know that they are a child of God and no one can convince them otherwise
 - That salvation is not earned by good works
 - That salvation is not lost by bad works, but that sin does have consequences
 - That church membership (or attendance at Sunday School) does not make one a Christian. Attending church helps children, youth and adults to grow in their understanding of the Bible.
 - That water baptism does not make you a Christian it demonstrates on the outside what happened on the inside.
- ✤ Experience the infilling of the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues
- ✤ Know how to talk to God (pray) in a living, personal way
- ✤ Have a daily Bible reading time
- ✤ Know the books of the Bible
- Know characters in the Bible and have a general understanding of the occurrences in their lives
- Have a basic understanding of how to live their Christian Life outside of church.
 - Making wise choices according to Biblical principles
 - Making godly friends
 - Being obedient to authority (parents and teachers)
 - Sharing with others about Jesus (evangelism)
- Know that they are unconditionally loved by God, demonstrated to them by their Sunday School teachers and church leaders
