#### II. Bible Story

Title: The Bible, God's Letter to Me!

Scriptures to Study: 2 Timothy 3:16-17; I Peter 2:2

Central Truth: The Bible is true. The Bible is God's letter to me. The Word of God

helps my spirit grow.

Visual Aids: A letter, fruit, vegetables, dustbin with trash inside, bottle of cleaning

chemical like Handy Andy or Vim

#### The Bible, God's Letter to Me!

### 1. The Bible contains truth; real stories.

The stories we read in the Bible are real, real stories. Some stories are make believe or pretend, like Cinderella or like the movie, Finding Nemo. But when we read in the Bible about Moses crossing through with several million people through a river, it really happened! There are actually parts of the original Bible that have been found in other parts of the world. God has made sure we have the truth about Himself written down for all to have access to.

## 2. The Bible is God's letter to me (wants me to know what he is like and truth that will help me in my life.)

How many of you have ever received a letter in the mail? It's exciting, isn't it? It usually contains information about friends or family; maybe a visitor. God wrote a letter to us, He is not far away and hiding Himself from us. He wants to help us and He wants us to know what He is like. There is truth in the Bible that will help us in our lives. For example, the Bible teaches us that it is more blessed to give than to receive. It's a good thing the Bible teaches us that, because I would think it's better to keep and take than it is to give. But because the Bible says it's better to give, we can be blessed! It's like if you buy a bicycle that isn't put together yet. Would it be easy to know how it fits together if you don't look at the instructions? No! You would probably have to put it together several times before you got it right! The Word of God helps us get our lives right the first time!

### 3. The Bible is the Word of God and it helps my spirit grow.

Our bodies need food to be strong. What are some healthy foods we can eat? (fruit, vegetables, meat, etc.) What are some foods we eat that are not very healthy? (sweets, chips). And can you think of some things a person could eat that would be dangerous? (cleaning chemicals, eating out of a rubbish bin, dirt or rocks.)

All of this can be like the kind of "food" we give our spirit man. Can you think of some healthy things we can feed our spirit? (the Word, good music, preaching at church or Bible study, talking with friends about Jesus). Can you think of some things that could be unhealthy or even dangerous for our spirit? (talking bad with friends, watching bad movies, looking at bad magazines or listening to non-Christian music.)

The Word of God is so important and I'm so thankful that I have this "instruction manual" for my life. It tells me how much God cares for me and how I can grow up to be a strong Christian.

#### VI. Activity

Name of activity: Through the Bible (from activity booklet)

Supplies needed: kids!

Instructions: Tell the kids that we are taking a trip through the Bible but will never leave our seats. Begin by saying "I took a trip through the Bible and found "Abraham". The next child will repeat what the teacher said and then add something they found that begins with the next letter in the alphabet and so on. So the second child says "I took a trip through the Bible and found Abraham and Beersheba". The third child says "I took a trip through the Bible and found Abraham, Baal and Canaan". Play continues for the whole alphabet.

Teacher: This game will help you have an understanding of where your children are at in their knowledge of the Bible. This curriculum series ("Bible Basics") is designed to give children an overview of the Bible, its contents and the people in it. .
